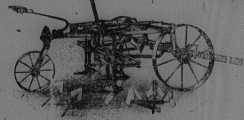

**Apricot Fritters**

**A Daily Recipe**  
by **Delmonico's Chef**  
(Apricot Fritters)

Mix one-half a pound of flour with one tablespoonful of oil or melted butter, a grain of salt, two eggs (add one after the other, one ounce of sugar. Beat gradually with one and a half teaspoon of cold milk. When about to use the batter, mix therein one and a half tablespoonful of baking powder.

Take some half preserved apricots, dry them on a napkin and sprinkle with flour. Dip them in batter and fry in hot fat. Drain on a napkin. Put the fritters on a tray, cover them with powdered sugar and place in a hot oven. Serve at once. (Proved to be precisely the same way for apples, pears, peaches, plums or banana fritters.)
