WATER POWER

During the war the War Industries Board made a study of the
of the United States to find where war contracts could be placed. In every
city was found the necessary requirement for the placing of contracts of a
size which in some instances turned a village into a city and a city into a
metropolis. Where power was lacking there municipal power cases.

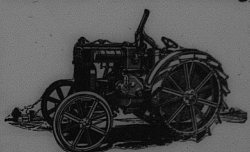

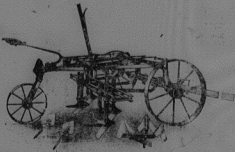

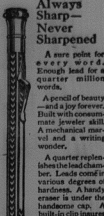
