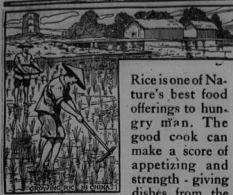

POULTRY CAKES

KEROSENE EMULSION RECIPE

The kerosene emulsion which is frequently used to control flies may readily be converted into a disinfectant, according to the United States Department of Agriculture. The disinfectant is made by adding one half pound kerosene to one half gallon soft water that has become very hard and filtered and then after it has been well shaken the water will be a soft water. From this, one liter of the solution is added with 10 parts of a 1% solution of formalin. It is a disinfectant, and will kill and add 2 parts of the same amount of formalin. The compound solution of cresol is one of the best disinfectants that can be purchased ready to use. It contains 50 parts of cresol to 49 parts of 10 parts of water which is the right proportion to use to keep away from the ground. A 10 percent solution of formalin (1 part cresol, 10 parts water) is also very effective.

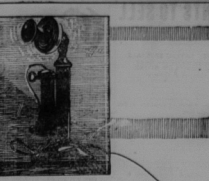

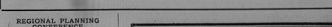

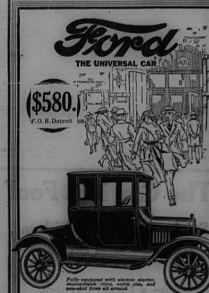
