PROPER CARE OF SHOES

Proper care of shoes adds a saving in shoe bills of from 25 to 50 per cent, says the bureau of chemistry, United States Department of Agriculture. At the same time it insures good-looking footwear. Proper care of shoes means:

- Have two pairs of shoes to wear on alternate days.
- Use shoe brush to remove the smallest traces of dirt.
- Keep heavy out-of-door work shoes clean and greased.
- Keep shoes dry at street wear.
- Have all repairs made as soon as needed.

Some important facts to remember are that:

- Wet leather is soft, and therefore readily scratched out of shape.
- Structure cut through wet leather is much more easily than through dry leather.
- Wet shoes and leathers wear away rapidly.
- Wet leather burns at a temperature that is only a little hotter than the hand can bear.
- If you use heat, wet leather shrinks, becomes hard and brittle.

- To dry wet shoes: Wipe off adhering mud and grit with rag.
- Brush shoes with shoe brush.
- Distribution the counter, heel, vamp, and toe to correct shape.
- Wipe with crumpled paper.
- Put the shoes in a place that is warm.
- The wet parts will dry very slowly.
- Wipe thoroughly dry before wearing.

CARE OF LEATHER BINDINGS

Material for binding in Bohemia Rubber Hinges and Break at Hinge Not Needed.

Bookbinding material has a tendency to dry out and become brittle, thereby breaking at the hinge. To keep the leather flexible, place the books, back to back, in a well-lighted airy place, and insert a wooden stick that is free from oil. Rub the hinge with a brush and a little leather. Be careful not to get any moisture on the surface of the book. Use small quantities of vasoline and rub with with a fine, flexible cloth and the hinge back. It is better to start with a very small quantity of vasoline and make several applications, according to the condition of the book rather than to use too much vasoline at first. It is best to do this work in summer. When greased, place a stick in dry for 24 to 48 hours and finally rub with the bureau of chemistry, United States Department of Agriculture.

- When washing windows or other paint just a little ammonia in the water. It makes glass shine and removes dirt.
- Always wash the window with soap, with plenty of water (rinse off the soap), is also care recommended for ammonia and developer.
