BLACK KNOT QUARTER DISEASE IN CHERRY

Discussed in *Cherry and Sometimes in Other-Cane*—Continued from Page 1.

There is a disease of cherry which leaves the very distinctive marks of black knot. It is observed on the young trees, and sometimes on the fruit, but they are more common than a swelling that is more general in the spring and later in the fall. The swelling may occur on the stem or on the fruiting spurs or may occur on the leaf.

Black knot is caused by a fungus that affects the wood, causing it to swell and rot. It is reported as a serious disease of the cherry, and one that should be carefully watched and kept under control. The fungus grows on the bark and in the heart of the tree.

Spores of the fungus are liberated in the spring. When introduced, either from the air or by insects, they enter the cracks which are being formed in the bark. With the opening of growth in spring, the black knot fungus reaches the leaf and leaf veins readily and enters the bark which at that time may increase a red leathery surface which rather quickly turns to a velvety dark green color. The hard tissue is covered with a dense mass of fungus, which is caused by the wind or rain during the summer months. The fungus is very active and people inside there are all more or less affected. Infections are a great enemy of the cherry, and it is very common to find one very weak in the following spring.

While spraying may be a refuge against the disease, it is not a sure cure. The control of black knot is to prevent the wind or rain from blowing the spores into the cracks. When this is done the disease is prevented. In doing this spraying is recommended that the cherry tree be sprayed as early as possible.
