Coming home from from a visit to a parishoner, Father Mohr found himself on the heights overlooking the little village, where a few lights glimmered in the silent darkness. So it must have been in Bethlehem on that silent, holy night when Christ was born. Silent night, holy night! Words came to him. He hastened home to put them down. The next day he showed them to his organist, Granz Gruber. As he read the words, Franz Gruber felt the beauty of that first holy night. There was no organ music in the church on Christmas Eve. But as Father Mohr sang, with Franz Gruber accompanying him on the guitar, the congregation listened in wonder to the first rendition of a song that was to be a Christmas gift to all the world ------"Silent Night".
