- The 1955-59 "Highway Patrol" television show lasted for 4 seasons of 39 episodes each for a total of 156 episodes.
- Each episode generally used multiple locations.
- Each episode of the series was filmed in a maximum of 2 to 3 days 1 day in the studio and 1 to 2 days on location.




1956, Season 1, Episode 27, scene from "Motorcycle A" at the "This is Chatsworth" sign, in front of Chatsworth Park Elementary










