documents as ration stamps. We would appreciate more. We are also asking if anyone out there could recommend a suitable speaker for this program...we're hoping for someone special.

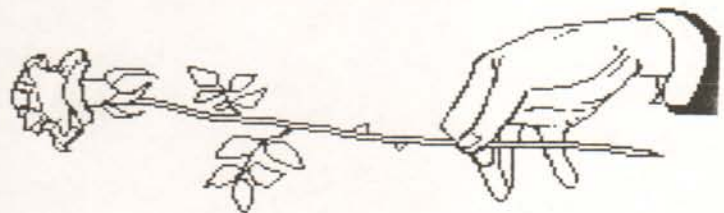

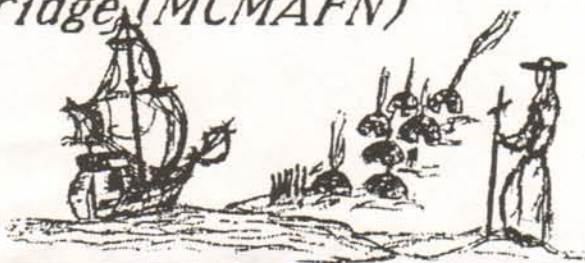
