## Memorial Day Services

A tender and touching tribute was paid to the departed and to the living when our Post #622 of the American Legion, under the direct charge of Commander George Cruse and James Nofsiger arranged and conducted the services at Oakwood Cemetery. Nine posts (Jewish War Veterans, VFW, Legionnaires and Auxiliaries) were represented in the processional which opened the services. Representatives from our Girl Scouts, Brownies, and Campfire Girls stood at attention while Karin Cruse, Jr. Hi Girl Scout, and Carol Riley, Mariner Scout, raised the Stars and Stripes.

The Van Nuys Chamber of Commerce Band, under the direction of Harley Fiscus, interspersed appropriate band selections through the hour-long program, and the West Valley Harmonettes, attired in black skirts and orchid note-embroidered blouses, rendered two selections: "I Heard a Forest Praying" and "We Do Not Walk Alone".

Steve Foote, Past Commander of the 20th District, gave General Logan's Orders for commemorating the first Memorial Day, and Rabbi Juda Hahn gave the invocation. Our budding vocalist with the million-dollar voice Virginia Ruff, sang all verses of "America" accompanied on the piano by Linda Rogers. Mrs. Myrtle Bradley sang "The Lord's Prayer" accompanied by her composer-husband, Mr. Scott Bradley.

Presentation of the Memorial Wreath was made by Commander George Cruse to the Gold Star Mothers, one our own Mrs. Pearl Wright of 21119 Chatsworth Street, and two other la-

dies from other posts. The Legionnaires formed the Honor Guard as the Gold Star Mothers placed the wreath in its position of honor at the foot of the flag, during which time Jay Ullis, baritone, sang "My Buddie" stirring many to open tears.

Representative Joe Holt gave the Address of the Day, paying tribute to the departed and stressed the forward look in working for world peace for which they contributed so much. Benediction was offered upon the congregation of approximately 500 by Dr. Harold Hayward of the Community Church. Taps were given by the trumpeters of the band, and the colors retired, which brought to a close another memorable service, a program well arranged and well executed by those in charge.

Grateful thanks go out to Oakwood Cemetery personnel who erected the platform and provided the piano, and who also furnished the printed program bulletins. A warm, slow, windless day for paying our respects to all of our departed loved ones, which love was manifested in the profusion of flowers which graced the grounds. Oakwood reports that approximately 10,000 people visited the cemetery on Memorial Day and the day before.

Our thanks to our Legion Auxiliary in setting aside an hour for us to remember.

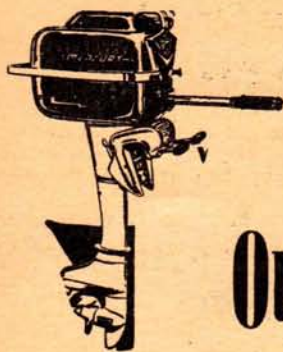


