This will raise \$485 million to purchase threatened open space for preservation of certain projects in the state. This will mean 10 million dollars for the Santa Susana Mountain Park area. This will also be the first park and wildlife bond act using the initiative process.

Our commitment is 50,000 signatures. We need each member to commit a minimum of 20 hours of time this summer from June through October to do this. It's the only game in town; it's now or never!

Your attendance Friday, February 27 at 7:30 pm is very important for the future. It is being called by PCL (Planning and Conservation League) which is sponsoring the bond act.
